

Monthly review

The ongoing war in the Middle East remained the dominant theme in August. In Europe, rising energy costs began to emerge in consumer price indices, while in the US, inflation gains slowed. Interest rates rose by around 10 basis points in Europe, pushing the German 10-year bond to a 15-year high. In the US, however, net movement during the month was essentially zero, reflecting a more wait-and-see stance by the Fed and the Treasury's announced measures to contain long-term rates. In this context, performance was slightly positive across all credit segments, with moderate outperformance in higher-beta segments, which benefited from a slight compression in spreads. On the program, the rise in rates weighed on the core portfolio, while the relative value book partially covered the decline in prices thanks to the short position on the nominal 10-year bond linked to the long position on the US breakeven and thanks to the long position on the Australian dollar, which reflected the movement of the currency against the dollar following Bessent's intervention at the end of the month.

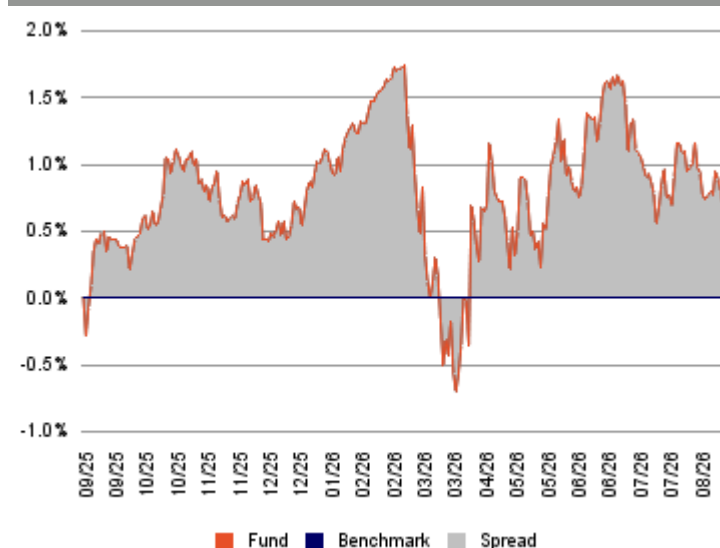

Investment objective

The fund pursues an absolute return objective with moderate volatility and a time horizon of 2-3 years. To achieve this objective, the fund adopts a discretionary investment style in which the control of risk factors is an integral, pervasive part of the investment process. Without any benchmark constraints, the fund will undertake the bond investments deemed the most attractive in terms of risk/return profile in the light of the prevalent market scenario. The fund may invest in bonds of all kinds and in other similar kinds of debt, exchange-traded funds (ETFs), undertakings for collective investment in transferable securities (UCITS) and other undertakings for collective investment (UCIs). It may invest in instruments denominated in currencies other than the euro and may hold liquidity of less than 50% of its net asset value (NAV). The fund will make use of listed and OTC derivative instruments to take long and short positions designed to take opportunistic advantage of the efficiencies identified from time to time in the various segments of the bond market.

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
