This Fund is managed by Ersel Gestion Internationale S.A.

Objectives and investment policy

This Fund is actively managed and seeks to grow capital and to generate income. The Fund does not aim to replicate the composition of the Benchmark: 20% Barclays EM USD Aggregate Sovereign (BSSU) hedged into EUR, 60% JPMorgan Global Bond Index EM Global Diversified (GBI-EMGD) USD (to be converted in EUR), 20% JPMorgan Corporate Emerging Market Index Broad Diversified (CEMI BD) hedged into EUR. The Fund also invests in securities which are not included in the indices or present in different proportions.

Degree of discretion with respect to the Benchmark: limited.

In order to achieve the above said aims the Fund invests mainly in bonds, in other transferable securities of the same nature, issued by (or relating to) States, by territorial public authorities, international public undertakings in emerging countries or companies belonging to emerging countries.

The maximum investment percentage in bonds convertible into shares may not exceed 25% of the net value of the Fund.

Up to 10% of the Fund's assets may be invested in Undertakings for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) or other Undertakings for Collective Investments (UCIs).

In order to achieve the above aims the Fund can use derivatives not only for hedging purposes.

The Fund's investment decisions are made on a discretionary basis.

Any income received by the Fund is reinvested.

The Fund's value is calculated and expressed in Euros.

Investors can buy or sell shares of the Fund on a daily basis (full bank business day).

Significant risk(s) for the Fund not taken into account in this indicator include the following:

Emerging market risk: The Fund invests in developing overseas markets which carry a higher risk than investing in larger established markets. Investments in emerging markets are likely to experience greater rises and falls in value and may suffer trading problems.

Currency risk: The Fund invests in overseas markets. It can be affected by changes in exchange rates which may cause the value of your investment to decrease or increase.

Credit risk: The Fund invests in bonds, cash or other money market instruments. There is a risk that the issuer may default. The likelihood of this happening will depend on the credit-worthiness of the issuer. The risk of default is usually greatest with bonds that are rated as sub-investment grade.

Counterparty risk: The counterparty risk may occur due to the fact that the Fund might have exposure through over-the-counter contracts with third parties.

The charges and commissions are used to cover the Fund's operating costs, including marketing and distribution of shares. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

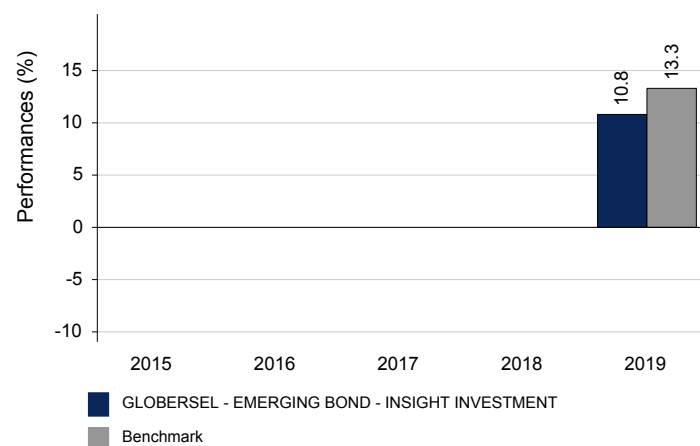
