



Monthly review

In July, inflation and labour market data came in weaker than expected; however, the market was once again dominated by developments in the Middle East. Yields rose again, with 10-year rates increasing by approximately 30 bps, leading to a moderate steepening of both the USD and EUR curves. The market interpreted the Fed's statements as signalling a more cautious stance on rates and priced in further curve steepening, with the US 30-year yield reaching its highest level since 2007. Spreads widened slightly in senior high yield, while tightening marginally in subordinated debt. High-grade segments posted negative returns of approximately 1 percentage point, while lower interest-rate sensitivity and relatively stable spreads supported performance in the higher-beta segment, which declined by approximately 0.5 percentage points over the month. The US dollar lost ground against all major G7 currencies (EUR/USD moved from 1.141 to 1.153), mainly due to the erosion of the Fed's credibility regarding its 2% inflation target. Against this backdrop, the fund maintained a constructive stance, keeping duration at around seven years.

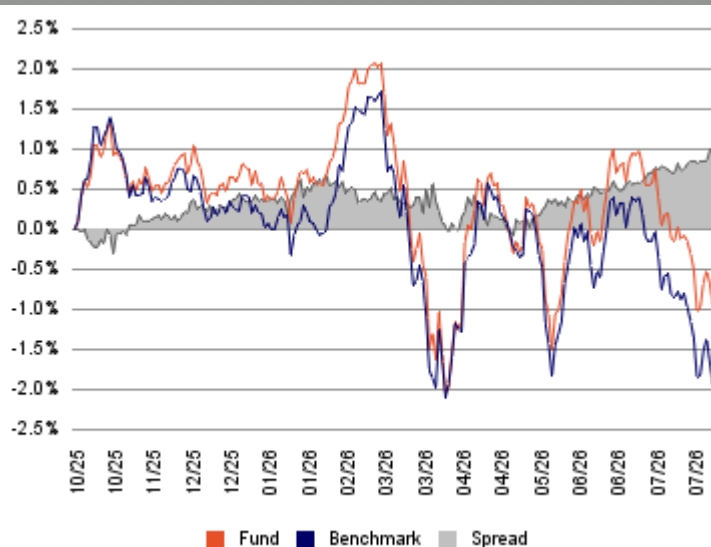

Investment objective

The fund is actively managed and its investment objective is to achieve capital growth by primarily investing in bonds or other fixed-income securities of a similar nature. The sub-fund applies a benchmark composed of the ICE BofA US Investment Grade Emerging Markets External Sovereign Index and may also invest in securities not included in the index or in different weightings. It can maintain a significant exposure to the US dollar and may additionally invest in any other fixed-income or credit instruments, whether fixed or floating rate, of any maturity, as well as convertible bonds, securities rated below Investment Grade or unrated, contingent convertible bonds (CoCos), distressed and defaulted debt securities in aggregate, bonds traded on the Chinese interbank bond market, and money market instruments with maturities of less than 12 months. To implement its investment strategy, the sub-fund may use derivative instruments not only for hedging purposes. Investment decisions are made on a discretionary basis. The sub-fund's net asset value (NAV) is calculated and expressed in euros.
