What is this product?

Type : Flexible fund, Income Accumulation

Objectives : The Fund is actively managed and aims to achieve gradual capital appreciation commensurate with reasonable risk. In pursuing this objective, the Fund's Manager uses fundamental analysis to select long and short investments mainly in equity exposure both equity securities and OTC derivatives. The Fund has no reference Benchmark. In order to realize its investment strategy, the Fund will invest mainly in different classes of international transferable securities, mainly equities and derivatives on equities, and, on a residual basis, in bonds, money market instruments and other derivatives.

Investment Policy: The Fund may:

- use OTC derivatives (such as, for example, contracts for difference or equity swap) in order to create long and short exposure.
- invest in ADR (American Depositary Receipts) or GDR (Global Depositary Receipt) on a tactical basis. All bonds will be investment grade.
- invest in instruments denominated in currencies other than the euro. The transferable securities in which the Fund will invest will be primarily issued by US, European and emerging markets issuers, with a limit of thirty per cent (30%) in securities issued by emerging markets issuers.
- invest, on a residual basis, in money market instruments with duration of less than twelve (12) months.
- hold cash, up to a maximum of 30% of its net assets.
- invest up to ten per cent (10%) of its net assets in UCITS, including ETF UCITS, or other UCI as referred to in art. 41, section 1, of the Law of 2010.
- use financial techniques and instruments in order to promote an efficient portfolio management, in accordance with the restrictions set forth in the "Financial techniques and instruments" chapter of the prospectus. The Fund may not invest in securities traded on the Russian Micex RTS market. The Fund takes into account the sustainability risks in its investment decisions and ESG criteria in the "ESG criteria and sustainability risks" chapter of the prospectus. The Fund's value is calculated and expressed in Euros.

Redemption: Unit holders may request redemption of the units at any time by sending an irrevocable redemption instruction to the Depositary Bank, to the Management Company, to the other banks or other institutions authorised for this purpose by the Management Company accompanied by subscription confirmations or certificates representative of units, as the case may be. Redemption lists are closed at the registered office of the Management Company by 4 p. m. of the banking day prior to the Calculation Date.

Maturity : The Fund is established without limits of duration

Intended retail investor : This Sub-Fund addresses to retail investors with a long-term (5 to 10 years) investment horizon willing to accept a high level of risk. The investor is warned that all investments involve a percentage of risk and that it cannot be guaranteed that investment policy objectives will be achieved. The minimum amount of the first subscription is 2,500 euro. No minimum amount for subsequent subscriptions.

However, in the event of the insolvency of the Depositary or a delegate thereof, the Fund may suffer a financial loss. However, this risk is mitigated to a certain extent by the fact the Depositary is required by law and regulation to segregate its own assets from the assets of the Fund. The Depositary will also be liable to the Fund and the investors for any loss arising from, among other things, its negligence, fraud or intentional failure properly to fulfill its obligations.

What are the costs?


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Past performance
