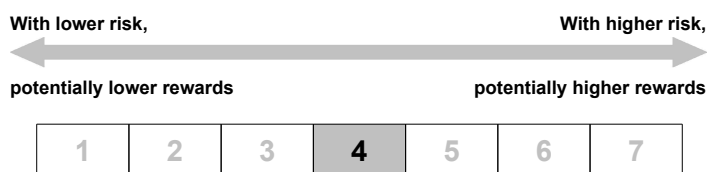

Objectives and investment policy

This Fund is actively managed and aims to maximize the invested capital. The Fund has no reference Benchmark. The Fund invests mainly in undertakings for collective investment ("UCIs") of shares, bonds, monetary securities in all currencies, open-end and closed-end, using alternative management techniques (hedge funds). Underlying UCIs may have been established not only in regulated markets, but also in non-regulated markets, moreover some underlying UCIs may have longer reimbursement periods than the Fund itself. The Fund may resort to financial techniques and instruments intended to hedge risks associated with stock market trends, interest rate fluctuations, and exchange rates. Financial techniques and instruments may also use for purposes other than hedging. Any income received by the Fund is reinvested. The Fund's value is calculated and expressed in Euro. Investors can buy or sell shares of the Fund on a weekly basis (each Tuesday).

Risk and reward profile



This indicator represents the annual historical volatility of the Fund over a 5-year period.

Risk Category 4 reflects average/moderate potential gains and/or losses for the portfolio. This is due to investments in diversified portfolio of bonds and mutual funds that invest in bonds, equities and money market securities on the international market.

Significant risk(s) for the Fund not taken into account in this indicator include the following:

Credit risk: The Fund invests in bonds, cash or other money market instruments. There is a risk that the issuer may default. The likelihood of this happening will depend on the credit-worthiness of the issuer. The risk of default is usually greatest with bonds that are rated as sub-investment grade.

Currency risk: The Fund invests in overseas markets. It can be affected by changes in exchange rates which may cause the value of your investment to decrease or increase.

Counterparty risk: The counterparty risk may occur due to the fact that the Fund might have exposure through over-the-counter contracts with third parties.

Charges

The charges and commissions are used to cover the Fund's operating costs, including marketing and distribution of shares. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

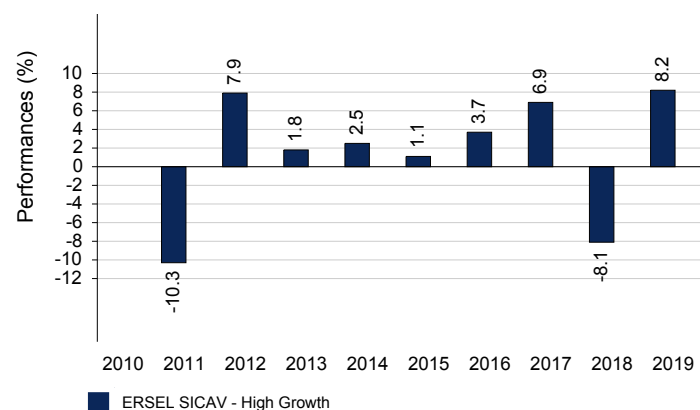
